



Jaded Week 1: Know-it-alls

How to Use Talk It Over:

This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Ax. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

Debbie's Main Idea:

"Know it alls" are jaded people who tend to cause a lot of damage to the relationships they have in their lives because they have become so dull, wearied and disillusioned. It is important to guard ourselves from the spiritual "know it all" and also be careful that we don't become one ourselves.

Discussion Questions:

- How do you deal with the "know it alls" that you've met in your life?
- Do you struggle with giving advice or your opinion to other believers all the time?
- Have you ever fallen into the trap of comparing yourself to other Christians?

Read and Discuss:

Philippians 2:1-8

- What does this verse tell you about how we are to behave as Christians?
- What is your biggest struggle in this verse?
- Selfishness, pride and ego are enemies of the image Jesus reflects; how do you guard yourself from becoming those things?

Next Steps:

Christianity is not a contest! Quit comparing yourself to others', read the bible, pray for people and ask God for humbleness.

A Verse to Memorize:

Ephesians 2:9 Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.
