How to Use Talk It Over:

This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Ax. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

Debbie's Main Idea:

Karma is a lie. Karma is a religious belief system that says there is a cause and effect in our lives. If we are good, then we will get good and if we are bad, we will get bad. In contrast, Christianity is only about God's grace not our own "goodness."

Discussion Questions:

- Do you understand what Karma is and how it differs from Christianity?
- Have you done "good" things so that you could get "good" things from God?
- Have you secretly or not so secretly wished that someone would be paid back for something that they did to you or your family?
- Have you worried about the "bad things" that you've done and that you would get "bad" back?
- Does it disappoint you that you can't cause God to give you good things?

Read and Discuss:

Galatians 6:7,8 NLT

Next Steps:

Ask God to help you to trust Him to set all things straight, and to forgive others. Be concerned with life that is eternal and not just temporal.

Watch your words and see if they align with God's Word.

A Verse to Memorize:

Titus 3:5 NLT He saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done but because of His mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit."
