How to Use Talk It Over:

This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Ax. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

Cameron’s Main Idea:

JESUS DESTROYED HURDLES THAT OUTSIDERS HAD TO JUMP IN ORDER TO PRAY.

Discussion Questions:

- Have you ever destroyed something? Was it fun?
- Were you surprised by how Jesus reacted so violently in the temple?
- Did Jesus tear down any hurdles in your own life that you thought you needed to clear before coming to a church?
- Are there any hurdles that you set up with people around you with whom you should be sharing your faith?
- Do you think churches should have any hurdles that outsiders must jump before participating in services and prayer? Why or why not?
- Was there anything in the message that stood out to you as interesting, intriguing, or challenging?

Read and Discuss:

Isaiah 56:1-8

- Is there anything we can learn about God, the world around us, or ourselves from this verse?
- Are there any modern day equivalents we can think of to replace “foreigner” and “eunuchs” in order to make this more applicable to today?
- If we are non-jewish people accepted by God, how should this shape our treatment of others?

Next Steps:

Take time to read your Bible daily and experience more of the stories that show how Jesus wasn’t weak and frail.

John 2:19 “Jesus replied, destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.”
