How to Use Talk It Over:

Discussion Questions:

- Do you have any stars or celebrities that you look up to or cheer for?
- Is the picture of how Jesus returns shocking to you? Why or why not?
- What are some ways you can see Satan is the, "god of this world" right now? What are ways that we can make Jesus "King of the Ring" in our own lives? What tries to steal the #1 spot in your life from Jesus?
- If we know Jesus is making a comeback and taking back his belt, how does that effect how we feel about the future?
- Was there anything in the message that stood out to you as interesting, intriguing, or challenging?

Read and Discuss:

2 Corinthians 4:1-7

- Is there anything we can learn about God, the world around us, or ourselves from this verse?
- What are some phrases Paul uses in these verses to show how we should keep Jesus as King of the Ring in our lives?
- How can you apply these verses to your life? Is there something you can change?

Next Steps:

Take time to read your Bible daily and experience more of the stories that show how Jesus wasn't weak and frail.

A Verse to Memorize:

2 Corinthians 4:5 "You see, we don't go around preaching about ourselves. We preach that Jesus Christ is Lord, and we ourselves are your servants for Jesus' sake."
