Discussion Questions:

- Have you ever thought about what you would be remembered for?
- If your life ended today, would you be satisfied with what people would remember?
- As far as your faith is concerned, have you been more of a Lydia or a Eutychus?
- What things about yourself do you wish to be remembered?

Read and Discuss:

- 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
- Is there anything we can learn about God, the world around us, or ourselves from this chapter?
- What should our reaction as Christians be to other believers who have died?
- Verse 18 says to encourage each other with these words. How would we do that?

Next Steps:

What do you need to do as you write these next chapters of your life so that your final chapter says what you want it to say?
