



Romantically Inclined Week 2: Courting

How to Use Talk It Over:

This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Ax. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

Cameron's Main Idea:

The Bible has some great pointers to the process of courting and following them will honor God and bless you.

Discussion Questions:

- If you are married, what do you remember from your courting years? If you are in this process, who are you courting and how long have you been with them?
- Was there anything in the message that stood out to you as interesting, intriguing, or challenging?
- Do you think that people in the world are courting at the right time? Too young / old?
- There are right and wrong people to court according to the Bible. Have you ever courted the wrong kind of person? What did you learn / take away?
- Cameron said that the 2nd biggest decision in your life that will affect your spiritual direction is who
 you marry. Do you agree? Why or why not?

Read and Discuss:

- I Corinthians 6:12-20
- Is there anything we can learn about God, the world around us, or ourselves from this verse?
- Why do you think God calls sexual sin, "a sin against your own body"?
- How do we live in response verses 19 and 20?

Next Steps:

- Is there anything going on in your life right now that the subgroup could be praying for you?
- Is there something that God is pointing out in your life in regards to this message which needs change or growth?

A Verse to Memorize:

Song of Solomon 7:7 - "You are slender like a palm tree, and your breasts are like it's clusters of fruit." (JUST KIDDING!)

I Peter 5:8 - "Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour."
