



Romantically Inclined Week 3: Idolatry

How to Use Talk It Over:

This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Ax. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

Cameron's Main Idea:

The world is serving an idol of sex. We as Christians must not become idolaters of sex but instead serve the one true Jesus of the Bible.

Discussion Questions:

- List a few of the most recent popular songs and see how many are worshipping the idol of sex.
- Was there anything in the message that stood out to you as interesting, intriguing, or challenging?
- An idol is anything we serve or obey above God. What are some intangible idols that our culture serves?
- The Bible tells us to run from sexual sin. Have you ever experienced this?
- Why do you think it is important that we stand below the word of God instead of on top of it? (Cameron's illustration from Sunday)

Read and Discuss:

(Ephesians 2:8-9) (Ephesians 4:17-32)

- Is there anything we can learn about God, the world around us, or ourselves from this verse?
- Some people will say these two verses are contradictory. What do you think?
- Is there something pointed out in the second verse that you find challenging?

Next Steps:

- Is there anything going on in your life right now that the subgroup could be praying for you?
- Does your current life worship Jesus or the idol of sex at this time?

A Verse to Memorize:

I Corinthians 6:18

"Run from sexual sin! No other sin so clearly affects the body as this one does. For sexual immorality is a sin against your own body."
