How to Use Talk It Over:

This resource is to help you and your group discuss, in greater detail, the messages at Ax. The hope is for you to remember the content, read scripture, and discuss the application to your own life.

Cameron's Main Idea:

OPPORTUNITY OFTEN LOOKS LIKE OPPOSITION

Discussion Questions:

- Share a story from your life where opposition turned out to be an opportunity.
- Was there any parts of the extra reading that was interesting or confusing?
- Did anything stand out to you in this message? Something new you haven't heard?
- What other Bible characters faced opposition that turned out to be opportunity?
- Are there any opportunities you have been missing because they look like opposition?

Read and Discuss:

1 Kings 17:1-24

- Was there anything in this verse that stood out to you?
- Why do you think Elijah ask to be fed first? Does this remind you of anything?
- Why do you think God allowed this woman's son to die?

Next Steps:

Identify the opposition to your calling and begin to look at it as an opportunity.

A Verse to Memorize:

Matthew 19:26 "Jesus looked at them intently and said, "Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But with God everything is possible."
